Purchase Havana Elementary School in order to remodel classrooms into affordable apartments for single veterans and married veterans with a family. Single apartments will rent for \$350.00/month and family apartments (2bedrooms) will rent for \$450.00/month. This will include utilities. There will be a cafeteria on site serving 3 meals daily and will be open to the public. Our target population are at risk Veterans and they will have priority over other applicants. Phase 1 will include conversion of 8 classrooms in building 6 & 7 into 12 two bedroom apartments and the classrooms in building 8 into 12 1 bedroom apartments. Building 5 is the cafeteria that will also require some remodeling. Move detail information is available in the business plan which is included with this request. A special note; after the initial startup cost, the project will fund all further expansion. As required, the project will offer 4-8 full time jobs. The projection is to house up to 75-80 Veterans (single/married). In addition to the above services, the project will be able to offer Job Fairs, Health Fairs and other community events. In the event of declared emergencies, we will offer short time shelter and be a distribution point for water and ice. The facility would be available to the county at no cost for their sponsored events. Secondary usage will be as a home to a number of Veteran Service Organizations.
