Purpose:

The Children's Behavior Health Training Program is designed to help teachers dealing with different types of children's issues such as bullying, eating disorders, depression, substance abuse, violence in schools, etc., so teachers are more skilled at giving the guidance and instruction children may need to become healthy, happy, mature adults.

The impact of this training could affect thousands of children in Dade, Duval, and Broward Counties during 2016-17. The CBHT program will be offered statewide in 2017-18.

Purpose of the Funding:

The requested funding would be used to organize and conduct five one-day seminars that would be open to up to 100 teachers each day. This would include salary for a program director to develop informational materials, distribute the materials to our member private schools and child care centers, as well as following up with personal contacts. Locations for the seminars would need to be found and scheduled, along with needing salaries for trainers.

Type and Amount of Services:

Our trained teachers would be qualified to interact with at-risk children to affect their quality of life, helping them to be happier and more enthusiastic. CEUs and Master In-service Points will be available for teacher participation.
