The \$140,000 will be spent on capital costs to install seven (7) new bus shelters in areas of the City that do not have bus shelters. Not only will these bus shelters affect Coconut Creek?s population (56,000); the City?s transit system connects with the Broward County system, meaning the population served extends beyond the City?s population to the surrounding cities, including students attending the City?s seven schools. The shelters will provide a level of protection from the elements for the bus-riding population of Coconut Creek and the surrounding areas who visit the City for school, work, shopping, or recreation.

The estimated cost for a bus shelter is \$20,000. The City has budgeted \$300,000 over the next five (5) years to replace current shelters (\$60,000/year over 5 years for a total of 15 replacement shelters). These funds would pay for seven (7) additional shelters.
