The construction of digital media labs will enable students and job-seekers of all ages to 1) expand their STEAM skills (science, technology, engineering, arts and math) for elementary school through college, 2) build their resumes and develop talents to make them more marketable to potential employers, 3) give local entrepreneurs access to training and equipment to help expand their market reach, and 4) offer artists a what they need to express their creativity. Library staff will support the labs by providing technology training classes for the public.
