The initial funding has been used to set up a physical center for practice and to begin building a professional and highly qualified infant mental health workforce. Recurring funding of \$1,000,000 will continue support of these positions and IFMHC operations. Twenty Five (25) candidates to participate in intensive clinical infant mental health training were recruited, qualified and subsequently admitted to an eighteen (18) month Child-Parent Psychotherapy (CPP) training to build capacity for therapeutic mental health services for young children and their families. In addition, training was provided to support the professional development of entry level infant mental health practitioners through the Infant-Family Mental Health Certificate Program at USFSP and community training in topics relevant to supporting families with very young children. This newly trained infant-family mental health professional workforce will provide the needed supports and services to children ages 0-5 years and their families in the Tampa Bay Community. The supported personnel include a Center Director, Training Director, Programs Director, Clinicians, and a Research Scientist.
