The following are the three areas being considered for traffic calming initiatives: Area A North Boundary: Hallandale Beach Boulevard South Boundary: County Line Road (NE 215th St.) Western Boundary: State Road 7 Eastern Boundary: SW 56th Avenue Area B North Boundary: Pembroke Road South Boundary: Hallandale Beach Blvd. Western Boundary: SW 58th Avenue Eastern Boundary: SW 40th Avenue Area C North Boundary: Hallandale Beach Boulevard South Boundary: County Line Road Western Boundary: SW 48th Avenue Eastern Boundary: SW 32nd Avenue The demands from cut-through traffic, wear and tear, connectivity for both motorized and non-motorized methods of transportation and pedestrian safety are featured throughout the City?s Traffic Calming Plans. We anticipate these improvements reducing vehicular accidents, and trip hazards. This project will impact two (2) counties and four 4 cities that come through our jurisdiction.
