The benefits from these funds will allow oyster reefs & sea grass beds to thrive and it will support over 1,200 commercial and recreational species of fish, crabs, shrimp, lobsters, including snook, grouper, snapper also sea turtles and manatees. The economic benefits of the estuary and Lagoon are \$ 3.78 billion annually. The restored habitats will directly benefit over 27,000 jobs representing over \$206 million in income also over \$519 million in direct marina sales, fishing bait & tackle and over \$ 115 million in tourism annually in St. Lucie and Martin County alone. Documented measures and performance data for the project will be kept. There are specific oyster recruitment and reef success monitoring done monthly and quarterly along with sea grass success and comparison to natural reefs and sea grass habitat.
