The Center for Translational Research in Neurodegenerative Disease (CTRND) at the University of Florida (UF) is a high-impact program of scientific discovery aimed at translating basic discoveries in neurodegenerative disease into therapies that benefit patients. Our major focus is on Alzheimer's and Parkinson's disease. These State funds have in the past and will continue to support the development of major programmatic initiatives at the UF CTRND and within the state, including, but not limited to, a NIH funded Alzheimer's Disease Research Center (ADRC) at UF (in collaboration with Mt. Sinai Medical Center, Miami, the University of Miami, FAU, and FIU) that has been recently awarded to UF from the National Institute on Aging. The funds will be used to support the center and additional research efforts designed to help us compete for i) a NIH funded Morris Udall Parkinson's Disease Center of Excellence, ii) other programmatic grants (PO1s) related to the study of neurodegenerative disorders, and iii) translational UO1 awards that move novel therapies for neurodegenerative disorders from the bench to bedside. In addition, these funds will enable us to engage in collaborative statewide activities to i) build an Alzheimer's disease research network that will benefit patients and increase the competitiveness of investigators at UF and throughout the state at the national level, ii) train a diverse workforce at all levels, from student to professional, in dementia and neurodegenerative disease research and support other research and training efforts aimed to impact these devastating disorders. Notably, with the \$3.5M State dollars we have received over the last three years, we have been able to garner over \$30M of new extramural funding (and we expect that figure to increase by the end of this fiscal year).
