Volusia County Schools has already committed and spent \$1.1 Million towards the current manufacturing program at Pine Ridge High School. The \$500,000 request will be used to purchase equipment to further enhance the training of the students at Pine Ridge, as well as equipment purchases for Galaxy Middle's new Maker Space Lab. The Volusia Manufacturer's Association has donated a 3-D Printer this year through a grant request from Galaxy Middle. The cost of the printer is valued at \$3000. The manufacturing program underway at Pine Ridge High School will ensure that there is a future pipeline for our local and statewide manufacturers. As of 2012, there were 436 manufacturing establishments throughout Volusia County. Students graduating from the Pine Ridge program will have industry certifications better preparing them to be workforce ready. The Make Space lab at Galaxy Middle will have many manufacturing components as a feeder to Pine Ridge High School. A 2012 report showed that students in Volusia County enrolled in academy or career programs held an average GPA of 3.1 as compared to other students that held an average of a 2.8 GPA. Students will be tracked through the normal grading process.
