The COPS grant consists of a four-year Problem Oriented Policing (POP) project beginning with the hiring and training of an additional 15 new sworn police officer positions in October, 2014. JSO replaced the 15 veteran officers and detectives who began to implement the POP strategies: Blight/Nuisance squad, a SiteSafe program, and a Group Violence Intervention Program.
