- 1.(a) Enable taxpayers to make Encourage private, voluntary contributions to nonprofit scholarship-funding organizations in order to promote the general welfare.
- 2. Provide taxpayers who wish to help parents with limited resources exercise their basic right to educate their children as they see fit with a means to do so.
- <u>3.(b)</u> Promote the general welfare by expanding Expand educational opportunities for children of families that have limited financial resources.
- 4.(c) Enable children in this state to achieve a greater level of excellence in their education.

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Improve the quality of education in this state, both by expanding educational opportunities for children and by creating incentives for schools to achieve excellence.

- PROGRAM; SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY. -- The Corporate Income Tax Credit Scholarship Program is established. A student is eligible for a corporate income tax credit scholarship if the student qualifies for free or reduced-price school lunches under the National School Lunch Act and:
- Was counted as a full-time equivalent student during the previous state fiscal year for purposes of state per-student funding;
- (b) Received a scholarship from an eligible nonprofit scholarship-funding organization or from the State of Florida during the previous school year; or
 - Is eligible to enter kindergarten or first grade.
- Contingent upon available funds, a student may continue in the scholarship program as long as the student's household family income level does not exceed 200 percent of the federal poverty level. A sibling of a student who is continuing in the program and resides in the same household as the student shall also be eligible as a first-time corporate income tax credit scholarship recipient as long as the student's and sibling's household income level does not exceed 200 percent of the federal poverty level.

 - (i) May use up to 3 percent of eligible contributions received during the state fiscal year in which such contributions are collected for administrative expenses that are incurred by the organization under this section. 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be expended for Must obligate, in the same fiscal year in which the contribution was received, 100 percent of the eligible contribution to provide annual or partial-year scholarships; however, up to 25 percent of the total contribution may be carried forward for expenditure in the following state fiscal year. A scholarship-funding organization must, before granting a scholarship for an academic year, document each scholarship student's eligibility for that academic year. A scholarshipfunding organization may not grant multiyear scholarships in one approval process. No portion of eligible contributions may be used for administrative expenses. All interest accrued from contributions must be used for scholarships.

Any and all information and documentation provided to the Department of Education and the Auditor General relating to the identity of a taxpayer that provides an eligible contribution under this section shall remain confidential at all times in accordance with s. 213.053.

(d) STATEWIDE BOARD OF GOVERNORS. The board of governors shall be a body corporate consisting of seventeen members. The board shall operate, regulate, control, and be fully responsible for the management of the whole university system. These responsibilities shall include, but not be limited to, defining the distinctive mission of each constituent university and its articulation with free public schools and community colleges, ensuring the well-planned coordination and operation of the system, and avoiding wasteful duplication of facilities or programs. The board's management shall be subject to the powers of the legislature to appropriate for the expenditure of funds, including setting tuition and fees, and the board shall account for such expenditures as provided by law. The governor shall appoint to the board fourteen citizens dedicated to the purposes of the state university system. The appointed members shall be confirmed by the senate and serve staggered terms of seven years as provided by law. The commissioner of education, the chair of the advisory council of faculty senates, or the equivalent, and the president of the Florida student association, or the equivalent, shall also be members of the board.
