Remove lines 7-18 and insert:

322.08, F.S.; revising provisions for required content in driver license application forms; requiring the application form for an original, renewal, or replacement driver's license to include language permitting the applicant to make voluntary contributions to Prevent Child Sexual Abuse and to Prevent Blindness Florida; requiring the application form for an original, renewal, or replacement identification card to include language permitting the applicant to make voluntary contributions to specified organizations; providing for distribution of funds collected from such contributions; providing that such contributions are not considered income of a revenue nature; repealing s. 322.18(9), F.S.; removing provisions requiring the application form for renewal issuance of a driver's license to include language permitting the applicant to make a voluntary contribution to Prevent Blindness Florida; removing provisions requiring the application form for renewal issuance or renewal extension of a driver's license to include language permitting the applicant to make a voluntary contribution to Family First; providing an effective date.
