Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (12) of section 215.5602, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

- (5) For the 2008-2009 Beginning in fiscal year and each fiscal year thereafter 2006-2007, the sum of \$8,640,000 \$9 million is appropriated annually from recurring funds in the General Revenue Fund to the Biomedical Research Trust Fund
