36 meeting the requirements of s. 322.09 certifies that he or she,  
37 or another licensed driver 21 years of age or older, has  
38 accompanied the applicant for a total of not less than 50 hours'  
39 behind-the-wheel experience, of which not less than 10 hours  
40 must be at night. This paragraph subsection is not intended to  
41 create a private cause of action as a result of the  
42 certification. The certification is inadmissible for any purpose  
43 in any civil proceeding.
