- Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent the ordinary maintenance and repair of the road or structures, provided the physical dimensions and location of the road and the appearance of any structure are preserved. However, the preservation of the road shall take priority over considerations of traffic management, and the public safety shall not be construed to require alterations in the road when alternative means promoting safety, including more restrictive traffic regulations, are available.
