 6 editorial changes; repealing s. 2 of Chapter 2004-32, Laws
 7 of Florida, which provides for repeal of the exemption;

 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 12 Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (5) of section
 13 119.071, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

14 119.071 General exemptions from inspection or copying of
 15 public records.--

16 (5) OTHER PERSONAL INFORMATION.--

17 (c) 1. For purposes of this paragraph, the term:

18 a. "Child" means any person younger than 18 years of age.

19 b. "Government-sponsored recreation program" means a
 20 program for which an agency assumes responsibility for a child
 21 participating in that program, including, but not limited to,
 22 after school programs, athletic programs, nature programs,
 23 summer camps, or other recreational programs.

24 2. Any Information that would identify or ~~help to~~ locate a
 25 child who participates in a government-sponsored recreation
 26 program ~~programs or camps or the parents or guardians of such~~
 27 ~~child, including, but not limited to, the name, home address,~~

29 ~~child; the names and locations of schools attended by such~~
 30 ~~child; and the names, home addresses, and social security~~
 31 ~~numbers of parents or guardians of such child~~ is exempt from s.
 32 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.

33 3. Information that would identify or locate a parent or
 34 guardian of a child who participates in a government-sponsored
 35 recreation program is exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a),
 36 Art. I of the State Constitution.

37 4. Information made exempt pursuant to this paragraph may
 38 be disclosed by court order upon a showing of good cause.

39 5. This exemption applies to records held before, on, or
 40 after the effective date of this exemption.

41 Section 2. Section 2. of Chapter 2004-32, Laws of Florida,
 42 is repealed.

43 Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
