 12 Section 1. Section 1004.4472, Florida Statutes, is amended
 13 to read:

 16 exemption.--

17 (1) For purposes of this section, the term:

18 (a) "Corporation" means the Florida Institute for Human
 19 and Machine Cognition, Inc.

20 (b) "Subsidiary" means a subsidiary authorized and
 21 approved by the corporation.

22 (2) The following information held by the corporation
 23 ~~Florida Institute for Human and Machine Cognition, Inc.,~~ or its
 24 ~~an authorized subsidiary of the corporation,~~ is confidential and
 25 exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State
 26 Constitution:

27 (a) Material relating to methods of manufacture or
 28 production, potential trade secrets, patentable material, actual

29 | trade secrets as defined in s. 688.002 or proprietary
 30 | information received, generated, ascertained, or discovered
 31 | during the course of research conducted by or through the

 34 | transactions resulting from such research.

35 | (b) Any information received by the corporation or a
 36 | subsidiary from a person from another state or nation or the
 37 | Federal Government which is otherwise exempt or confidential
 38 | pursuant to the laws of that state or nation or pursuant to
 39 | federal law.

40 | (c) Any information received by the corporation or a
 41 | subsidiary in the performance of its duties and responsibilities
 42 | which is otherwise confidential and exempt by law.

43 | (d) All identifying information of a donor or prospective
 44 | donor to the corporation or a subsidiary who wishes to remain
 45 | anonymous.

46 | (3)-(2) The corporation or its subsidiary shall permit any
 47 | governmental entity to inspect or copy confidential and exempt
 48 | information held by the corporation or its subsidiary which is
 49 | necessary for that governmental entity to perform its duties and
 50 | responsibilities. ~~Any governmental entity that is permitted to~~
 51 | ~~inspect or copy confidential and exempt information held by the~~
 52 | ~~corporation or a subsidiary shall maintain the confidential and~~
 53 | ~~exempt status of that information.~~

54 | (4)-(3) That portion of a meeting of the corporation or a
