- amount," "generation-skipping transfer tax exemption," "GST
 exemption," "marital deduction," "maximum marital deduction,"
 "unlimited marital deduction," or "maximum charitable
 deduction;"
 - (b) Measures a share of a trust based on the amount that can pass free of federal estate tax or the amount that can pass free of federal generation-skipping transfer tax;
 - (c) Otherwise makes a disposition referring to a charitable deduction, marital deduction, or another provision of federal estate tax or generation-skipping transfer tax law; or
 - (d) Appears to be intended to reduce or minimize federal estate tax or generation-skipping transfer tax.
 - (2) For the purpose of this section:
 - (a) "Applicable period" means a period beginning January 1, 2010, and ending on the end of the day on the earlier of (i)

 December 31, 2010, or (ii) the day before the date that an act becomes law that repeals or otherwise modifies or has the effect of repealing or modifying s. 901 of The Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001.
 - (b) A "disposition occurs" when an interest takes effect in possession or enjoyment.
 - (3) In construing the trust, the court shall consider the terms and purposes of the trust, the facts and circumstances surrounding the creation of the trust, and the settlor's probable intent. In determining the settlor's probable intent, the court may consider evidence relevant to the settlor's intent even though the evidence contradicts an apparent plain meaning of the trust instrument.

- (4) This section does not apply to a disposition that is specifically conditioned upon no federal estate or generation-skipping transfer tax being imposed.
- (5) Unless otherwise ordered by the court, during the applicable period and without court order, the trustee administering a trust containing one or more provisions described in subsection (1) may:
 - (a) Delay or refrain from making any distribution;
- (b) Incur and pay fees and costs reasonably necessary to determine its duties and obligations (including compliance with provisions of existing and reasonably anticipated future federal tax laws); and
- (c) Establish and maintain reserves for the payment of these fees and costs and federal taxes.

The trustee shall not be liable for its actions as provided in this subsection made or taken in good faith.

- (6) The provisions of this section are in addition to, and not in derogation of, rights under this code or the common law to construe a trust.
- (7) This section is remedial to provide a new or modified legal remedy. This section shall have retroactive effect and be effective as of January 1, 2010.

Section 1. Section 948.101, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

- 948.101 Terms and conditions of community control and criminal quarantine community control.-
- (1)The court shall determine the terms and conditions of community control. Conditions specified in this subsection do not require oral pronouncement at the time of sentencing and may be considered standard conditions of community control.
- (a) The court shall require intensive supervision and surveillance for an offender placed into community control, which may include but is not limited to:
- (a) 1- Specified contact with the parole and probation officer.
- (b) 2. Confinement to an agreed-upon residence during hours away from employment and public service activities.

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- (c) 3. Mandatory public service.
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- (d) 4. Supervision by the Department of Corrections by means of an electronic monitoring device or system.
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- $\underline{\text{(e)}}$ 5. The standard conditions of probation set forth in s. 948.03.

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(b) For an offender placed on criminal quarantine community control, the court shall require:

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1. Electronic monitoring 24 hours per day.

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2. Confinement to a designated residence during designated hours.

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The enumeration of specific kinds of terms and (2) conditions does not prevent the court from adding thereto any other terms or conditions that the court considers proper. However, the sentencing court may only impose a condition of supervision allowing an offender convicted of s. 794.011, s. 800.04, s. 827.071, s. 847.0135(5), or s. 847.0145 to reside in another state if the order stipulates that it is contingent upon the approval of the receiving state interstate compact authority. The court may rescind or modify at any time the terms and conditions theretofore imposed by it upon the offender in community control. However, if the court withholds adjudication of quilt or imposes a period of incarceration as a condition of community control, the period may not exceed 364 days, and incarceration shall be restricted to a county facility, a probation and restitution center under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections, a probation program drug punishment phase I secure residential treatment institution, or a community residential facility owned or operated by any entity providing such services.

(3) The court may place a defendant who is being sentenced for criminal transmission of HIV in violation of s. 775.0877 on criminal quarantine community control. The Department of Corrections shall develop and administer a criminal quarantine community control program emphasizing intensive supervision with 24-hour-per-day electronic monitoring. Criminal quarantine community control status must include surveillance and may include other measures normally associated with community control, except that specific conditions necessary to monitor this population may be ordered.

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 948.11, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

- 948.11 Electronic monitoring devices.-
- (1) (a) The Department of Corrections may, at its discretion, electronically monitor an offender sentenced to community control.
- (b) The Department of Corrections shall electronically monitor an offender sentenced to criminal quarantine community control 24 hours per day.
