- (5) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), a solid waste landfill closure account is created within the Solid Waste Management Trust Fund to provide funding for the closing and long-term care of solid waste management facilities. The department may use funds from the account to contract with a third party for the closing and long-term care of solid waste management facilities if:
- (a) The facility had or has a department permit to operate the facility;
- (b) The permittee provided proof of financial assurance for closure in the form of an insurance certificate;
- (c) The facility has been deemed to be abandoned or has been ordered to close by the department;

Between lines 182 and 183, insert:

Section 4. The sum of \$2,888,460 in nonrecurring funds is appropriated to the Department of Environmental Protection from the Solid Waste Management Trust Fund in the Fixed Capital Outlay-Agency Managed-Closing and Long-Term Care of Solid Waste Management Facilities appropriation category pursuant to s. 403.709(5). This section is effective upon the act becoming law.

Section 5. Except as otherwise provided, this act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
