7 1001.41 General powers of district school board.—The

 10 considering recommendations made by a member of the board, shall  
 11 exercise the following general powers:

12 (1) Determine policies and programs consistent with state  
 13 law and rule deemed necessary by it for the efficient operation  
 14 and general improvement of the district school system.

15 (2) Adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54 to  
 16 implement the provisions of law conferring duties upon it to  
 17 supplement those prescribed by the State Board of Education and  
 18 the Commissioner of Education.
