8 multidisciplinary team may consult with law enforcement agencies
9 and victim advocate groups during the assessment and evaluation
10 process. A member of the multidisciplinary team may conduct a
11 clinical evaluation of the person. A second clinical evaluation
12 shall be conducted if any member of the multidisciplinary team
13 questions the conclusion of the first clinical evaluation. All
14 members of the multidisciplinary team shall review at a minimum
15 the information provided in subsection (2) and any clinical
16 evaluations prior to making a recommendation.

17 (f) After all clinical evaluations have been completed, the

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18 multidisciplinary team shall produce a written assessment and
19 recommendation as to whether the person meets the definition of
20 a sexually violent predator, which shall be provided to the
21 state attorney.

22 1. The multidisciplinary team must recommend that the state
23 attorney file a petition for civil commitment if at least two
24 members of the multidisciplinary team determine that the person
25 meets the definition of a sexually violent predator.

26 2. If the multidisciplinary team recommends that a person
27 who has received a clinical evaluation does not meet the
28 definition of a sexually violent predator, the written
29 assessment and recommendation shall be sent to the state
30 attorney. If the state attorney questions the negative

recommendation to the state attorney; requiring the
