Section \_\_\_. Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (5) of section 1004.435, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

1004.435 Cancer control and research.

- (5) RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS, THE H. LEE MOFFITT CANCER CENTER AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE, INC., AND THE STATE SURGEON GENERAL.—
- (c) The Board of Governors or the State Surgeon General, after consultation with the council, may adopt rules necessary for the implementation of this section.
- (d) The State Surgeon General, after consultation with the council, shall make rules specifying to what extent and on what terms and conditions cancer patients of the state may receive financial aid for the diagnosis and treatment of cancer in any hospital or clinic selected. The department may furnish to citizens of this state who are afflicted with cancer financial aid to the extent of the appropriation provided for that purpose in a manner which in its opinion will afford the greatest benefit to those afflicted and may make arrangements with hospitals, laboratories, or clinics to afford proper care and treatment for cancer patients in this state.
