The 20 21 notice must include a summary of the agency's statement of the estimated regulatory costs, if one has been prepared, based on 22 the factors set forth in s. 120.541(2); a web address where the 23 statement of estimated regulatory cost can be viewed in its 24 entirety on each agency's website; a statement that any person 25 who wishes to provide the agency with information regarding the 26 27 statement of estimated regulatory costs, or to provide a 28 proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative as provided by s. 120.541(1), must do so in writing within 21 days after 29 publication of the notice; and a statement as to whether, based 30 31 on the statement of the estimated regulatory costs or other information expressly relied upon and described by the agency if 32 no statement of regulatory costs is required, the proposed rule 33 is expected to require legislative ratification pursuant to s. 34 120.541(3). The notice must state the procedure for requesting a 35 public hearing on the proposed rule. Except when the intended 36 action is the repeal of a rule, the notice must include a 37 reference both to the date on which and to the place where the 38 notice of rule development that is required by subsection (2) 39 40 appeared.

66 statement of estimated regulatory costs of the proposed rule, as provided by s. 120.541. However, an agency need not prepare a 67 statement of estimated regulatory cost for rule repeals unless 68 such repeal would impose any regulatory cost. In any challenge 69 70 to a rule repeal, such rule repeal must be considered 71 presumptively correct by the Joint Administrative Procedures 72 Committee, in any proceeding before the Division of Administrative Hearings, or in any proceeding before a court of 73 competent jurisdiction. However, an agency must prepare a 74 statement of estimated regulatory costs of the proposed rule, as 75 76 provided by s. 120.541, if: a. The proposed rule will have an adverse impact on small 77 78 business; or b. The proposed rule is likely to directly or indirectly 79 80 increase regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate in this state within 1 year after the implementation of the 81 82 rule. 83 2. Small businesses, small counties, and small cities.-84 a. 120.541 Statement of estimated regulatory costs.-

Within 21 days after publication of the notice (1)(a)required under s. 120.54(3)(a), a substantially affected person may submit to an agency a good faith written proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative to a proposed rule which substantially accomplishes the objectives of the law being implemented. The proposal may include the alternative of not adopting any rule if the proposal explains how the lower costs and objectives of the law will be achieved by not adopting any rule. If such a proposal is submitted, the 90-day period for filing the rule is extended 21 days. Upon the submission of the lower cost regulatory alternative, the agency shall prepare a statement of estimated regulatory costs as provided in subsection (2), or shall revise its prior statement of estimated regulatory costs, and either adopt the alternative or provide a statement of the reasons for rejecting the alternative in favor of the proposed rule.

(b) If a proposed rule will have an adverse impact on small business or if the proposed rule is likely to directly or indirectly increase regulatory costs, in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within 1 year after the implementation of the rule, the agency shall prepare a statement of estimated regulatory costs as required by s. 120.54(3)(b).

(6) The Department of State shall maintain the Florida 165 Administrative Register that includes web addresses where
