85 | approved specialty license plate if the number of valid

86 | specialty plate registrations falls below 1,000 plates for at

89 | the total number of valid specialty plate registrations is below

 398 education to raise awareness of the importance of beekeeping to
 399 Florida agriculture and to fund honeybee research and husbandry.

400 (83) AMERICAN EAGLE LICENSE PLATES.—

401 (a) The department shall develop an American Eagle license
 402 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate
 403 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The
 404 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the
 405 words "God Bless America" must appear at the bottom of the
 406 plate.

407 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
 408 be distributed to the American Eagle Foundation for deposit in
 409 the foundation's national endowment fund. Up to 10 percent of
 410 the funds received may be used for administrative costs and
 411 marketing of the plate. The American Eagle Foundation shall use
 412 the remainder of the proceeds to fund public education programs,
 413 rescue and care programs, and other conservation efforts in
 414 Florida that benefit bald eagles.

416 (a) The department shall develop a Dan Marino Foundation
 417 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
 418 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
 419 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
 420 plate, and the words "Marino Campus" must appear at the bottom
 421 of the plate.

422 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
 423 be distributed to the Dan Marino Foundation, Inc., a Florida
 424 nonprofit corporation, which may use up to 10 percent of such
 425 fees for administrative costs and marketing of the plate. The

426 remainder of the fees shall be used by the Dan Marino
 427 Foundation, Inc., to assist Floridians with developmental
 428 disabilities in becoming employed, independent, and productive;

 435 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the
 436 words "Conserving Florida Wetlands" must appear at the bottom of
 437 the plate.

438 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
 439 be distributed to Ducks Unlimited, Inc., a nonprofit corporation
 440 under s. 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to be used as
 441 follows:

442 1. Up to 5 percent may be used for administrative costs
 443 and marketing of the plate.

444 2. At least 95 percent shall be used in this state to
 445 support the mission and efforts of Ducks Unlimited, Inc., to
 446 conserve, restore, and manage Florida's wetlands and associated
 447 habitats for the benefit of waterfowl, other wildlife, and
 448 people.

449 (86) FLORIDA BAY FOREVER LICENSE PLATES.—

450 (a) The department shall develop a Florida Bay Forever

451 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
 452 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
 453 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
 454 plate, and the words "Florida Bay Forever" must appear at the
 455 bottom of the plate.

456 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
 457 be distributed to the Florida National Park Association, Inc.,
 458 which may use up to 10 percent of the proceeds for
 459 administrative costs and marketing of the plate. The remainder
 460 of the funds shall be used to supplement the Everglades National
 461 Park's budgets and to support educational, interpretive,
 462 historical, and scientific research relating to the Everglades
 463 National Park.

464 Section 4. This act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
