

(80) FALLEN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS LICENSE PLAT

(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Police and Kids Foundation, Inc., which may use up to a maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds for marketing to promote and market the plate. All remaining proceeds shall be distributed to and used by the Police and Kids Foundation, Inc., for its operations, activities, programs, and projects The remainder of the proceeds shall be used by the Police and Kids Foundation, Inc., to invest and reinvest, and the interest earnings shall be used for the operation of the Police and Kids Foundation, Inc.

(84) AMERICAN EAGLE LICENSE PLATES.-

- (a) The department shall develop an American Eagle license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "God Bless America" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
- (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed to the American Eagle Foundation for deposit in the foundation's national endowment fund. The American Eagle Foundation shall use the proceeds to fund public education programs, rescue and care programs, and other conservation efforts in Florida that benefit bald eagles.
 - Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2017.

Presented to the Transportation & Infrastructure Subcommittee

Guest Speaker, Al Cecere-Founder & President of the American Eagle Foundation

Purpose:

- On behalf of the not-for-profit American Eagle Foundation and myself, we would like to personally thank you for helping the American Eagle Foundation in establishing a Bald Eagle specialty license plate in the State of Florida.
- Florida has one of the largest populations of wild bald eagle breeding/nesting pairs in the lower 48 states.
- With such a large and emerging population, the American Eagle Foundation desires to help fund various programs and projects to further Bald Eagle care, protection, research, and public education programs in Florida.

Background Information:

- The American Eagle Foundation (AEF) is a not-for-profit organization of concerned citizens and professionals founded in 1985 to develop, assist and conduct various eagle and environmental conservation programs in the United States.
- Our primary goal is to fully restore the majestic Bald Eagle, the U.S.A.'s National Symbol, to America's lands, waterways and skies, and to help "Build A Nest-Egg" for their future care and protection.
- The Foundation is a 501(c) (3) tax-exempt public charity, and donations to support its mission and efforts are tax-deductible. The AEF has been sponsored by and headquartered at Dolly Parton's Dollywood theme park in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee for the past 27 years.

Endowment Fund/Grant Program:

- The American Eagle Foundation has established a national endowment fund benefiting eagle care, protection and research projects. All proceeds received from specialty license plate sales will be held in this endowment and periodically distributed for aiding Florida eagle projects and programs.
- The fund's earnings from license plate sales will be utilized to provide annual grants to various eagle related projects and programs benefiting Eagles in Florida.
- Grants will be allocated for conservation, monitoring, educational, and research projects, based on a rating of most need and greatest benefit to Bald Eagles in Florida.
- Each year, the AEF will accept grant applications from legitimate and qualified agencies and programs within the State of Florida.
- The AEF has a Bald Eagle Grant Advisory Team (BEGAT), consisting of eagle experts, representing federal, state, and private agencies from all regions of the country who will determine what projects and programs will receive annual support from the license plate revenue fund.
- BEGAT advises AEF concerning:
- a) Grant criteria, subject to annual refinements.
- b) Rating of the relative merits of applications for AEF grants for Bald Eagle projects and programs.

AEF involvement in Florida Programs:

• N.E. Florida Eagle Nest Cam for public education:

For the past three years, the AEF has fully funded a public education program in North East Florida by placing several video cams and microphones on the wild nest of Bald Eagle pair "Romeo" and "Juliet," which has had over 2.8 million page views by people and school children in Florida and across the USA during the 2015/2016 nesting/breeding season alone. This project has been in operation since 2013.

· Florida Audubon:

The AEF has also supported other care eagle efforts in Florida. Since 2012, the AEF has donated about \$48,500 to the Florida Audubon Center for Birds of Prey from the AEF's national endowment fund.

· Wildlife Sanctuary of Florida:

For many years, the AEF has supported and worked closely with the Wildlife Sanctuary of Florida. In cooperation with the US Fish & Wildlife Service and Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, the AEF has one of the only remaining hacking programs in the South-east United States. As of 2017, the AEF has released 150 young Bald Eagles into the Foothills of the Great Smoky Mountains in efforts to help repopulate Bald Eagles in Tennessee. The AEF has partnered with the Wildlife Sanctuary of Florida to release juvenile Bald Eagles hatched at their Florida center.

• Additionally, the AEF staff has traveled to Florida to conduct numerous eagle-related public education and rescue programs. The most recent education appearance was at the Men's College National Football Championship in Tampa.

The AEF conducts its activities in Florida in cooperation with the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service and the Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission.

Conclusion:

- The AEF desires to support various additional eagle care, education, protection and enhancement programs within the State of Florida from the funds raised through the proposed Bald Eagle specialty license plate.
