1	DOC	From Specific Appropriation *****, \$150,000 from nonrecurring general revenue funds is appropriated to the Pinellas Ex-offender Re-entry Coalition to address the needs of ex-offenders transitioning from incarceration back into society.	House
2	GAL	The funds in Specific Appropriation ***** shall not be utilized for any costs related to the potential expansion of floor space operated and managed by the Northwest Regional Data Center.	House
3	AG/DLA	From the funds in specific appropriation *****, \$50,000 in nonrecurring general revenue funds is provided to the Haitian Lawyers Association.	House
4	DJJ	From the funds in Specific Appropriations 1128 through 1213, the Department of Juvenile Justice is authorized to conduct a comprehensive statewide review of county-level data, including a gap analysis of services and programs available across all counties in the state, to evaluate the implementation of juvenile justice policies at the county level. As the result of such review, the department may prepare a report that includes benchmarking of counties' performance on factors that demonstrate how a county is supporting the Department's strategic goals of preventing and diverting more youth from entering the juvenile justice system; providing appropriate, less restrictive, community-based sanctions and services; reserving serious sanctions for youth who pose the greatest risk to public safety; and focusing on rehabilitation. Any report may also include recommendations and strategies that can be implemented by the department or counties to address any identified deficiencies and to assist in developing a statewide, coordinated response across all of Florida's communities to support the department's strategic goals. A copy of any report that is prepared pursuant to this authorization shall be submitted to the Governor, President of the Senate, and Speaker of the House of Representatives.	House
5	SCS	From the funds in Specific Appropriation ***** through *****, the Office of the State Courts Administrator may expend up to \$10,000 to issue a solicitation to review document integrity and authentication systems and technology available that may eliminate fraud in the processing of court documents. Under the direction of the Florida Courts Technology Commission, the Office of the State Courts Administrator shall develop specifications for the system and technology in consultation with the Department of Corrections and the Florida Clerks of Court. The Office of the State Court Administrator may issue the solicitation no later than October 1, 2014, and shall follow a competitive solicitation process consistent with section 287.057, Florida Statutes.	House
6	SCS	The funds in Specific Appropriation ***** are provided for new construction, remodeling, maintenance, repair, security enhancement, or building enhancement issues for the Second, Third, Fourth, and/or Fifth District Courts of Appeal.	House

1	DOC	The Legislature hereby adopts by reference the changes to the approved operating budget as set forth in Budget Amendment EOG B2014-0407 as submitted on March 24, 2014, by the Governor on behalf of the Department of Corrections for approval by the Legislative Budget Commission. The Governor shall modify the approved operating budget for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 consistent with the amendment. This section is effective upon becoming law.	House
2	SCS	The Legislature hereby adopts by reference the changes to the approved operating budget as set forth in Budget Amendment EOG B2014-0457 as submitted on April 17, 2014, by the Chief Justice on behalf of the State Courts System for approval by the Legislative Budget Commission. The Chief Justice shall modify the approved operating budget for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 consistent with the amendment. This section is effective upon becoming law.	House
