The notification must include the full name, Florida medical license number, specialty, and address of the a designated supervising physician. Any subsequent changes in the designated supervising physician shall be reported to the department within 30 days after the change. Assignment of a designated supervising physician does not preclude a physician assistant from practicing under multiple supervising physicians.

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Between lines 200 and 201, insert:

20 Upon employment as a physician assistant, a licensed physician assistant must notify the department in writing within 21 22 30 days after such employment and provide or after any 23 subsequent changes in the supervising physician.
