Section 1. A task force shall be established within the Department of Education for the purpose of studying the implications and efficacy of implementing policies that emphasize performance-based pay for teachers and policies that raise the standards for teacher certification. The task force shall also study the impact of requiring district school boards to adopt salary schedules that compensate their instructional personnel and school-based administrators on the basis of performance. The task force, in coordination with the Office of



Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability, shall submit a report containing its findings, recommendations, and strategies to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on or before July 1, 2012.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
