The Committee on Criminal Justice (Dean) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete lines 988 - 1005 and insert:

Section 21. Subsection (3) of section 402.302, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

402.302 Definitions.-

8 (3) "Child care personnel" means all owners, operators, 9 employees, and volunteers working in a child care facility. The 10 term does not include persons who work in a child care facility 11 after hours when children are not present or parents of children 12 in Head Start. For purposes of screening, the term includes any



13 member, over the age of 12 years, of a child care facility operator's family, or person, over the age of 12 years, residing 14 15 with a child care facility operator if the child care facility is located in or adjacent to the home of the operator or if the 16 17 family member of, or person residing with, the child care facility operator has any direct contact with the children in 18 19 the facility during its hours of operation. Members of the operator's family or persons residing with the operator who are 20 21 between the ages of 12 years and 18 years shall not be required 22 to be fingerprinted but shall be screened for delinguency 23 records. For purposes of screening, the term shall also include 24 persons who work in child care programs which provide care for 25 children 15 hours or more each week in public or nonpublic 26 schools, summer day camps, family day care homes, or those programs otherwise exempted under s. 402.316. The term does not 27 28 include public or nonpublic school personnel who are providing 29 care during regular school hours, or after hours for activities related to a school's program for grades kindergarten through 30 31 12. A volunteer who assists on an intermittent basis for less 32 than 10 40 hours per month is not included in the term 33 "personnel" for the purposes of screening and training, provided 34 a person who meets the screening requirement of s. 402.305(2) is 35 always present and has the volunteer in his or her line of sight 36 that the volunteer is under direct and constant supervision by 37 persons who meet the personnel requirements of s. 402.305(2). 38 Students who observe and participate in a child care facility as 39 a part of their required coursework shall not be considered child care personnel, provided such observation and 40 41 participation are on an intermittent basis and a person who

42 <u>meets the screening requirement of s. 402.305(2) is always</u> 43 <u>present and has the student in his or her line of sight</u> the 44 students are under direct and constant supervision of child care 45 personnel.

Section 22. Paragraphs (i) and (k) of subsection (2) of section 409.175, Florida Statutes, are amended, present paragraphs (b) and (c) of subsection (5) of that section are redesignated as paragraphs (c) and (d), respectively, and a new paragraph (b) is added to that section to read:

51 409.175 Licensure of family foster homes, residential 52 child-caring agencies, and child-placing agencies; public 53 records exemption.-

(2) As used in this section, the term:

55 (i) "Personnel" means all owners, operators, employees, and 56 volunteers working in a child-placing agency, family foster 57 home, or residential child-caring agency who may be employed by 58 or do volunteer work for a person, corporation, or agency which holds a license as a child-placing agency or a residential 59 child-caring agency, but the term does not include those who do 60 61 not work on the premises where child care is furnished and 62 either have no direct contact with a child or have no contact 63 with a child outside of the presence of the child's parent or guardian. For purposes of screening, the term shall include any 64 65 member, over the age of 12 years, of the family of the owner or 66 operator or any person other than a client, over the age of 12 67 years, residing with the owner or operator if the agency or 68 family foster home is located in or adjacent to the home of the 69 owner or operator or if the family member of, or person residing 70 with, the owner or operator has any direct contact with the

Members of the family of the owner or operator, or 72 persons residing with the owner or operator, who are between the ages of 12 years and 18 years shall not be required to be 73 74 fingerprinted, but shall be screened for delinguency records. For purposes of screening, the term "personnel" shall also 75 76 include owners, operators, employees, and volunteers working in 77 summer day camps, or summer 24-hour camps providing care for 78 children. A volunteer who assists on an intermittent basis for 79 less than 10 40 hours per month shall not be included in the 80 term "personnel" for the purposes of screening, provided a 81 person who meets the screening requirement of this section is 82 always present and has the volunteer in his or her line of sight that the volunteer is under direct and constant supervision by 83 84 persons who meet the personnel requirements of this section. (k) "Screening" means the act of assessing the background of 85 86 personnel and includes, but is not limited to, employment 87 history checks as provided in chapter 435, using the level 2 standards for screening set forth in that chapter. Screening for 88 89 employees and volunteers in summer day camps and summer 24-hour camps and screening for all volunteers included under the 90 definition of "personnel" shall be conducted as provided in 91 92 chapter 435, using the level 1 standards set forth in that 93 chapter. 94 95 96 And the title is amended as follows: 97 Delete line 50 98 and insert: 99 submission of fingerprints; amending s.402.302, F.S.;
