64 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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66 Section 1. Doolittle Raiders Highway designated;
67 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

68 (1) That portion of State Road 285 in Okaloosa and Walton
69 Counties which is located north of College Boulevard in
70 Niceville is designated as "Doolittle Raiders Highway."

71 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
72 suitable markers designating Doolittle Raiders Highway as
73 described in subsection (1).

74 Section 2. Beach Highway designated; Department of
75 Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

76 (1) That portion of U.S. 331 from the Alabama state line
77 to U.S. 98 in Walton County is designated as "The Beach
78 Highway."

79 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
80 suitable markers designating The Beach Highway as described in
81 subsection (1).

82 Section 3. Command Sergeant Major Gary Lee Littrell Medal
83 of Honor Causeway and Bridge designated; Department of
84 Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

85 (1) That portion of State Road 682 (Pinellas Bayway) from
86 State Road 699 (Gulf Boulevard) to U.S. 19 in Pinellas County is
87 designated as "Command Sergeant Major Gary Lee Littrell Medal of
88 Honor Causeway and Bridge."

89 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
90 suitable markers designating the Command Sergeant Major Gary Lee
91 Littrell Medal of Honor Causeway and Bridge as described in
92 subsection (1).

93 Section 4. Perdido Key Parkway designated; Department of
94 Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

95 (1) That portion of State Road 292 from Blue Angel Parkway
96 to the beginning of Perdido Key Drive in Escambia County is
97 designated as "Perdido Key Parkway."

98 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
99 suitable markers designating Perdido Key Parkway as described in
100 subsection (1).

101 Section 5. Andrew J. Capeletti Memorial Ramp designated;
102 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

103 (1) The ramp that connects northbound Homestead Extension
104 of Florida's Turnpike to northbound Interstate 75 in Miami-Dade
105 County is designated as "Andrew J. Capeletti Memorial Ramp."

106 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
107 suitable markers designating Andrew J. Capeletti Memorial Ramp
108 as described in subsection (1).

109 Section 6. Jose Regueiro Avenue designated; Department of
110 Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

111 (1) That portion of W. 20th Avenue in the City of Hialeah
112 between W. 44th Place and Okeechobee Road in Miami-Dade County.

113 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
114 suitable markers designating Jose Regueiro Avenue as described
115 in subsection (1).

116 Section 7. That portion of S.W. 67th Avenue (Ludlam Road)
117 between Bird Road and S.W. 136th Street in the City of South
118 Miami and the Village of Pinecrest in Miami-Dade County is
119 designated as a state historic road. No public funds shall be
120 expended for any of the following purposes:

121 (1) To cut or remove any tree having a diameter at its
122 thickest part in excess of 6 inches within 35 feet of either
123 side of the paved surface of the road or to engage in an
124 activity which requires the removal without the replacement of
125 such tree.

126 (2) The alteration of the physical dimensions or location
127 of S.W. 67th Avenue, the median strip thereof, or the land
128 adjacent thereto, except:

129 (a) Routine or emergency utilities maintenance activities
130 necessitated to maintain the road as a utility corridor.

131 (b) Modifications or improvements made to provide for
132 vehicular ingress and egress of governmental safety vehicles.

133 (c) Alterations, modifications, or improvements made for
134 the purpose of enhancing life safety vehicular use or pedestrian
135 use, or both, of S.W. 67th Avenue, as long as such alterations,
136 modifications, or improvements are heard in a public hearing and
137 subsequently approved by the governing board of the local
138 government in which such alterations, modifications, or
139 improvements are located.

140 (3) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent

141 the ordinary maintenance and repair of the road or structures,
142 provided the physical dimensions and location of the road and
143 the appearance of any structure are preserved. However, the
144 preservation of the road shall take priority over considerations
145 of traffic management, and the public safety shall not be
146 construed to require alterations in the road when alternative
147 means promoting safety, including more restrictive traffic
148 regulations, are available.

149 Section 8. Trooper Claude Baker Memorial Highway
150 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
151 markers.—

152 (1) That portion of State Road 45 in Sarasota County from
153 Constitution Boulevard in Sarasota to River Road in Venice is
154 designated as "Trooper Claude Baker Memorial Highway."

155 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
156 suitable markers designating Trooper Claude Baker Memorial
157 Highway as described in subsection (1).

158 Section 9. Gretchen Evans Memorial Bridge designated;
159 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

160 (1) The bridge on U.S. 98 in Wakulla County at the Wakulla
161 River is designated as "Gretchen Evans Memorial Bridge."

162 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
163 suitable markers designating Gretchen Evans Memorial Bridge as
164 described in subsection (1).

165 Section 10. Earl S. "Coach" Kitchings Avenue designated;
166 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

167 (1) That portion of Edgewood Avenue West in Duval County
168 from New Kings Road (U.S. 1) to Lem Turner Road is designated

169 the "Earl S. 'Coach' Kitchings Avenue."

170 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
171 suitable markers designating the Earl S. "Coach" Kitchings
172 Avenue as described in subsection (1).

173 Section 11. Coach Jermaine D. Hall Memorial Highway
174 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
175 markers.—

176 (1) That portion of I-95 from Baymeadows Road in Duval
177 County to State Road 16 in St. Johns County is designated the
178 "Coach Jermaine D. Hall Memorial Highway."

179 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
180 suitable markers designating the Coach Jermaine D. Hall Memorial
181 Highway as described in subsection (1).

182 Section 12. Veterans Memorial Highway designated;
183 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

184 (1) That portion of State Road 26 between the Levy County
185 line and the Alachua County line in Gilchrist County is
186 designated as "Veterans Memorial Highway."

187 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
188 suitable markers designating Veterans Memorial Highway as
189 described in subsection (1).

190 Section 13. Sergeant Ricky Lord Road designated;
191 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

192 (1) That portion of State Road 26 between the Levy County
193 line and County Road 313 in Gilchrist County is designated as
194 "Sergeant Ricky Lord Road."

195 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
196 suitable markers designating Sergeant Ricky Lord Road as

described in subsection (1).

Section 14. Julia Tuttle Way designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) That portion of Biscayne Boulevard Way between S.E. 2nd Avenue and U.S. 1 (Biscayne Boulevard) in Miami-Dade County is designated as "Julia Tuttle Way."

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Julia Tuttle Way as described in subsection (1).

Section 15. Cpl. Christopher Lee Poole, Jr., Memorial Highway designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) That portion of Old U.S. Highway 441 in Mt. Dora from the intersection of State Road 19A to Alexander Street is designated the "Cpl. Christopher Lee Poole, Jr., Memorial Highway."

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating the Cpl. Christopher Lee Poole, Jr., Memorial Highway as described in subsection (1).

Section 16. Sgt. Frederico G. Borjas Memorial Highway designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) That portion of State Road 44 east of Eustis beginning at the intersection of County Road 44 and ending just west of County Road 439 is designated the "Sgt. Frederico G. Borjas Memorial Highway."

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating the Sgt. Frederico G. Borjas

225 Memorial Highway as described in subsection (1).

226 Section 17. Johnny C. Treadwell Memorial Highway
227 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
228 markers.—

229 (1) That portion of State Road 46 near Sorrento from Round
230 Lake Road to County Road 437 is designated the "Johnny C.
231 Treadwell Memorial Highway."

232 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
233 suitable markers designating the Johnny C. Treadwell Memorial
234 Highway as described in subsection (1).

235 Section 18. Orange Bowl Way designated; Department of
236 Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

237 (1) Northwest 77th Court in Miami Lakes is designated as
238 "Orange Bowl Way."

239 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
240 suitable markers designating Orange Bowl Way as described in
241 subsection (1).

242 Section 19. Purple Heart Highway designated; Department of
243 Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

244 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 27 between the Florida-
245 Georgia border in Gadsden County and Biscayne Bay in Miami-Dade
246 County is designated as "Purple Heart Highway."

247 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
248 suitable markers designating Purple Heart Highway as described
249 in subsection (1).

250 Section 20. Heather Hurd Memorial Highway designated;
251 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

252 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 27 in Polk County between

253 Sand Mine Road and U.S. Highway 192 is designated as "Heather
254 Hurd Memorial Highway."

255 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
256 suitable markers designating Heather Hurd Memorial Highway as
257 described in subsection (1).

258 Section 21. Michael G. Rippe Parkway designated;
259 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

260 (1) Upon its completion, that portion of SR 739 in Lee
261 County known as the Metro Parkway Extension between Six Mile
262 Cypress Parkway and U.S. 41/Alico Road is designated as "Michael
263 G. Rippe Parkway."

264 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
265 suitable markers designating Michael G. Rippe Parkway as
266 described in subsection (1).

267 Section 22. K. Earl Durden Highway designated; Department
268 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

269 (1) That portion of State Road 79 in Bay County from U.S.
270 Highway 98 to the B.V. Buchanan Bridge in West Bay is designated
271 as "K. Earl Durden Highway."

272 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
273 suitable markers designating K. Earl Durden Highway as described
274 in subsection (1).

275 Section 23. Colonel Bud Day Boulevard designated;
276 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

277 (1) That portion of State Road 397 from Government Avenue
278 to the North gate of Eglin Air Force Base in Okaloosa County is
279 designated as "Colonel Bud Day Boulevard."

280 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect

281 suitable markers designating Colonel Bud Day Boulevard as
282 described in subsection (1).

283 Section 24. Miss Lillie Williams Boulevard designated;
284 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

285 (1) That portion of N.W. 79th Street between N.W. 6th
286 Avenue and E. 12th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated as
287 "Miss Lillie Williams Boulevard."

288 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
289 suitable markers designating Miss Lillie Williams Boulevard as
290 described in subsection (1).

291 Section 25. Army Sergeant Daniel L. McCall Memorial
292 Highway designated; Department of Transportation to erect
293 suitable markers.—

294 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 90 between Avalon
295 Boulevard and Pace Patriot Boulevard in the City of Pace in
296 Santa Rosa County is designated as "Army Sergeant Daniel L.
297 McCall Memorial Highway."

298 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
299 suitable markers designating Army Sergeant Daniel L. McCall
300 Memorial Highway as described in subsection (1).

301 Section 26. Anthony J. Perez Street designated; Department
302 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

303 (1) That portion of 40th Street/Bird Road between 102nd
304 Avenue and 117th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated as
305 "Anthony J. Perez Street."

306 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
307 suitable markers designating Anthony J. Perez Street as
308 described in subsection (1).

309 Section 27. John Torrese Family Road designated;
310 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

311 (1) That portion of State Road 997 between S.W. 288th
312 Street and S.W. 344th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated
313 as "John Torrese Family Road."

314 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
315 suitable markers designating John Torrese Family Road as
316 described in subsection (1).

317 Section 28. Manuel Capo Way designated; Department of
318 Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

319 (1) That portion of S.W. 88th Street between S.W. 137th
320 Avenue and S.W. 142nd Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated
321 as "Manuel Capo Way."

322 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
323 suitable markers designating Manuel Capo Way as described in
324 subsection (1).

325 Section 29. Manuel Capo Boulevard designated; Department
326 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

327 (1) That portion of S.W. 8th Street between S.W. 24th
328 Avenue and S.W. 27th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated
329 as "Manuel Capo Boulevard."

330 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
331 suitable markers designating Manuel Capo Boulevard as described
332 in subsection (1).

333 Section 30. Lt. Colonel Charles Brown Memorial Highway
334 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
335 markers.—

336 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 1 (State Road 5) between

S.W. 104th Street and S.W. 112th Street in Miami-Dade County is designated as "Lt. Colonel Charles Brown Memorial Highway."

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Lt. Colonel Charles Brown Memorial Highway as described in subsection (1).

Section 31. Subsection (1) of section 585.61, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

585.61 Animal disease diagnostic laboratories.—

(1) There is hereby created and established an animal disease diagnostic laboratory in Osceola County and Suwannee County. The laboratory complex in Osceola County is designated as the "Bronson Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory."

377 Section 35. Judge Perry Wells Highway designated;
378 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

379 (1) That portion of State Road 277 between State Road 79
380 and U.S. Highway 90/State Road 10/Jackson Avenue in Washington
381 County is designated as "Judge Perry Wells Highway."

382 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
383 suitable markers designating Judge Perry Wells Highway as
384 described in subsection (1).

385 Section 36. Vernon Bridge designated; Department of
386 Transportation to erect suitable markers.-

387 (1) Upon completion of construction, Bridge number 610147
388 and Bridge number 610146 on State Road 79 north of the City of
389 Vernon in Washington County are designated as "Vernon Bridge."

390 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect

480 Section 47. Cuban-American Association of Civil Engineers
481 Way designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
482 markers.—

483 (1) That portion of N.W. 107th Avenue in Miami-Dade County
484 between Flagler Street and N.W. 7th Street is designated "Cuban-
485 American Association of Civil Engineers Way."

486 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
487 suitable markers designating Cuban-American Association of Civil
488 Engineers Way as described in subsection (1).

489 Section 48. Dr. Edward Cole Highway designated; Department
490 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

491 (1) That portion of Interstate 175 in Pinellas County
492 between Interstate 275 and 4th Street is designated as "Dr.
493 Edward Cole Highway."

494 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect
495 suitable markers designating Dr. Edward Cole Highway as
496 described in subsection (1).
