Per the SFWMD ?BMP for South Florida Urban Stormwater Management Systems?, the project's proposed exfiltration trench system has varying effectiveness in removing suspended sediment, total phosphorus, total nitrogen, oxygen demand, trace metals and bacteria. Estimated removal is 40% to 100%. The anticipated effectiveness of the proposed projects improvements is also supported by the Statewide BMP Efficiencies for Nonpoint Source Mngt of Surface Waters as published by FDEP 10/12/2016.
