Funding will be used for the dredging of canals at Keaton Beach and Keaton Beach boat ramp and the basin at Steinhatchee Boat ramp. These boat ramps currently have a \$14m economic impact on the local economy and creates 190 jobs. Taylor County's tourism is largely dependent on recreational fishing, boating, and scalloping. 65.7% of boaters who access the Gulf from these two boat ramps are from out of county and 33% are from out of state.
