According to a Northwest Florida Skilled Technician Task Force report (2013), advanced manufacturing is one of the emerging economic drivers within the four westernmost counties in Florida. Manufacturing represents a target industry for regional economic development organizations, as it contributed \$2.6B in total 2013GDP and represents 14,518 jobs across West Florida. The sector generates \$985 million in total earnings, equal to \$67,872 in earnings for each worker employed in the industry.
