In the 1970s, nearly two million tires were dumped into the Atlantic in an unsuccessful attempt to create an artificial reef. Broward County received support from the Department of Defense?s Civil-Military Innovative Readiness Training Program as well as the state of Florida. Additional funding to FDEP would allow for cleanup to be completed more quickly.
