Funds will be used to support the Prodigy Cultural Arts program. Prodigy is a research-driven prevention and diversion program for at-risk youth ages 7-17. Prodigy uses the cultural arts infused with life skills, academic enrichment and family support services empower young people. Since its inception in 2000, over 28,500 youth have participated in the program. For 15 years, Prodigy was under the Florida Department of Juvenile Justice and boasted an over 85% non-recidivism rate as well as most
