Haney's Auto Service Technology program operates at maximum student capacity with a wait list. It is housed in original 1979 construction and requires extensive renovation and updating to meet current industry standards, alleviate safety concerns, update technology and facilities, and prepare our students to meet employment needs. Our solid four year average job placement rate is 80%, and there are currently 622 regional job openings with high anticipate growth.

The Bay Economic Development Alliance and Bay County Chamber of Commerce also provided letters endorsing this project and its positive economic impact. NATEF industry certification requirements necessitate these upgrades.

Security measures are required for inventory control purposes.
