Most of Waldo's wastewater collection system ranges from 50 to 80 years old with vitrified clay pipes in very poor condition. Associated brick manholes are also in very poor condition. The entire collection system is subject to dramatic infiltration/inflow during wet weather events. This results in the City being charged high wastewater usage fees by the receiving facility, Gainesville Regional Utilities (GRU) with every major storm event. Periodic line collapses have occurred which create a dan
