11. What is the specific purpose or goal that will be achieved by the funds being requested?

USF developed the Travel Assistance Device (TAD) prototype mobile application to assist those with intellectual and cognitive disabilities to be able to navigate the public transportations system. This proposed project will expand the TAD prototype and integrate it with OneBusAway (OBA), an open-source real-time transit information mobile app. OBA currently has over 340,000 existing users in seven cities, including over 34,000 in the Tampa Bay area on many platforms including Android and iOS.

Development cost to enhance features of the service has lacked funding since 2013 include the TAD integration, adding other modes of transportation (e.g. bikeshare, TNCs), regional fare collection, and advance trip planning functionality.
  - 14f. Based upon the identified business objectives or needs, what are the success factors that must be realized in order for the state agency to consider the proposed IT project a success?

In addition to the source code and mobile app deliverable, success factors would include in the final report the results of the following metrics: TAD Reliability testing, trips planned and app downloads to measure effectiveness, customer level satisfaction, and productivity by the number of trainees trained to use the service.

In early 2016, the City of Tampa with as many of as 40 letters of support from major and private institutions, submitted an application for the US DOT Smart Cities Initiative. Among several projects contained, the application included provisions for enhancing OneBusAway to support new modes of transportation such as autonomous vehicles and connected vehicles. By having the TAD integration with OBA, those with intellectual disabilitie will have the equality to use these services as well.
