According to the 2017-18 Regional Demand Occupations List, Information Security Analysts, an occupation primarily associated with cybersecurity, is the 2nd highest growth occupation among information technology occupations in Miami-Dade County. According to the Economic Modeling Specialists Inc (EMSI), jobs in this industry are expected to grow 5.6% over the next 3 years in Miami-Dade County. In 2016, there were 1,987 unique job postings within this industry, averaging 181 monthly postings.

- Multiple types of training courses based on students' level of expertise in cyber security. For entry level participants, a four-week training will cover essentials of cyber security, and include hands-on learning simulation labs. Participants will be able to earn two certifications. For current security professionals, one-week training courses will focus on reality-based scenario threats, the tools to prevent them, and efficient responses. Both types of training will cover security best practice
