Ch. 267.1735 requires that UF ensure the long-term preservation of state-owned historic properties in St. Augustine. A shortage in annual maintenance funding does not allow for repair and replacement of roofs for properties. For example, historic preservation standards require that wood-shake roofs be replaced with wooden shakes (2x the cost).

In 2007, Section 267.1735 was created by the Legislature transferring the responsibility for management of certain historic properties, consisting of 35 buildings, in St. Augustine from the city to the University of Florida. Legislative intent was to "ensure long-term preservation and interpretation while facilitating an educational program at UF. Since the beginning, UF has spent approximately \$20M in state, private, and grand funds on building preservation and delivery of educational programs.

Contractors and engineers have verified roof leaks and roof failure.
