    School teachers will assess the social and emotional skills of students in two elementary schools and two middle schools, potentially as many as 4,000 students. The majority of students will receive guidance and coaching from their teacher. Those students whose needs go beyond what can be provided in the classroom will be recommended for referral for individualized counseling and treatment outside of the classroom.
  - 17b. Describe the direct services to be provided to the citizens by the funding requested.

Students who need stronger social and emotional skills will be identified and either receive coaching in the classroom or, if their needs go beyond what is available in the classroom, be encouraged to receive counseling by professionals in the community. If the program is successful, teachers will be able to focus more of their time on educational instruction and less time on disciplinary actions.
