16a. Please Describe:

Per Florida Charts, Leon County has an estimated 2,500 children with at least one incarcerated parent in the state prisons system. One out of nine black children has an incarcerated parent per Pew Charitable Trust. Leon County shows a 57.3% poverty level as compared to

the state of 53.4% by Florida Charts. Black children account for one-third of population, but are arrested 75% more, adjudicated 80% more, and 90% more committed to residential programs.

The program enhances children's education with positive reinforcement through parental involvement, one-to-one tutors and mentors. It provides cross-curricular tie with homework assistance, utilize computer labs for achieving skills in math and language arts, build character and confidence, with positive reinforcement allowing parents to be more actively involved and engaged with their child. Incorporating STEAM activities to include field trips and lab activities.
