1		New Proviso Prom the funds in Specific Appropriation 692, no privately operated work release center may house more than 200 inmates at any given time. In addition, each facility with 100 or more inmates in its work release program must have at least one certified correctional officer on premises at all times. A person who was a certified correctional officer at the time of seperating or retiring from the Department of Corrections in good standing is considered to be a certified correctional officer for this purpose unless his or her certification has been revoked for misconduct.

The current 44-year-old building is experiencing a mold outbreak associated with an inadequate heating, ventilation, and air conditioning system, requires significant renovations to comply with the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA), and requires renovations to address United States Marshals' Service security assessment deficiencies. The new courthouse will be located on a smaller footprint and will be more efficient than the current facility, resulting in immediate savings in operational and maintenance costs.
