9 (a) The right of persons to lawfully provide for their own
10 health care shall not be denied or abridged by the State or its

13 purchase health care coverage. This prohibition shall not apply
14 to voluntary participation in employer-sponsored health care
15 coverage, or any purchase of health care coverage in exchange
16 for a public privilege or benefit.

18 (1) The term "person" means any natural person,

27 **ARTICLE I, SECTION 28**

28 HEALTH CARE.-- Proposing an amendment to the State
29 Constitution to provide that the right of persons to lawfully
30 provide for their own health care shall not be denied or
31 abridged by the State or its political subdivisions. The State
32 and its political subdivisions are prohibited from compelling
33 any person to purchase health care coverage. This prohibition
34 shall not apply to voluntary participation in employer-sponsored
35 health care coverage, or any purchase of health care coverage in
36 exchange for a public privilege or benefit. The amendment
37 defines "person" as any natural person, corporation and/or
38 business entity. The amendment provides that the term political
39 subdivision be defined by general law.
