On line 50, after the period (.)

Notwithstanding the foregoing, sovereign immunity shall not apply to claims for bodily injury or death made against any person or entity who is a licensed health care provider acting within the course and scope of any agency relationship with a for-profit subsidiary where such bodily injury or death is legally caused by treatment or therapy, except when such treatment or therapy is undertaken pursuant to a research study conducted with the written informed consent of the patient, and as otherwise required by state and federal law governing human experimental treatment or therapy.
