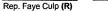

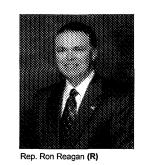

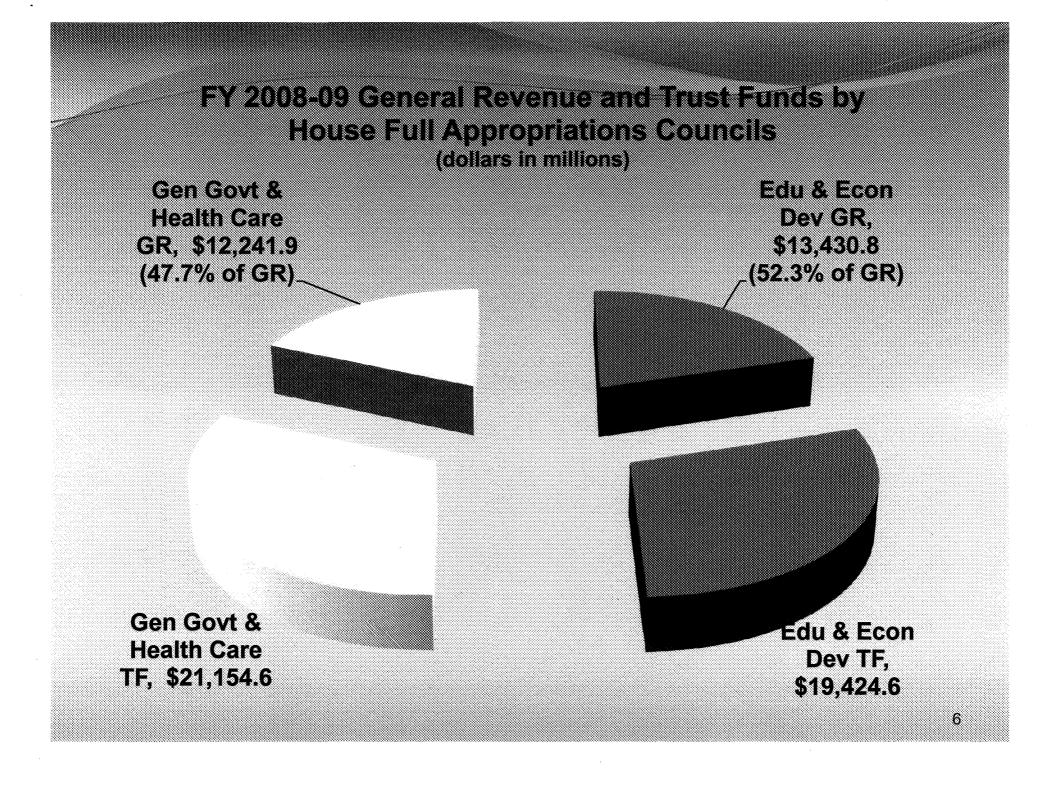
## Total State FY 2008-09 Appropriations- \$66.3 billion by House Full Appropriations Councils

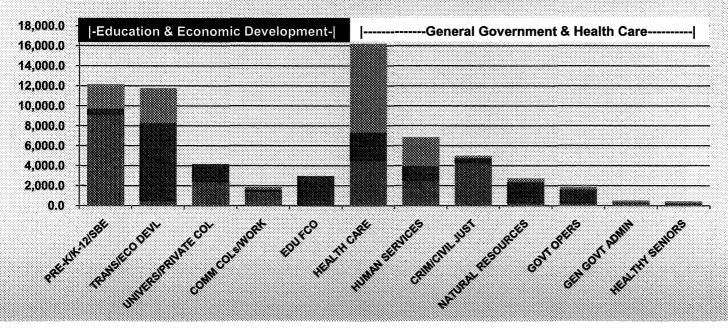

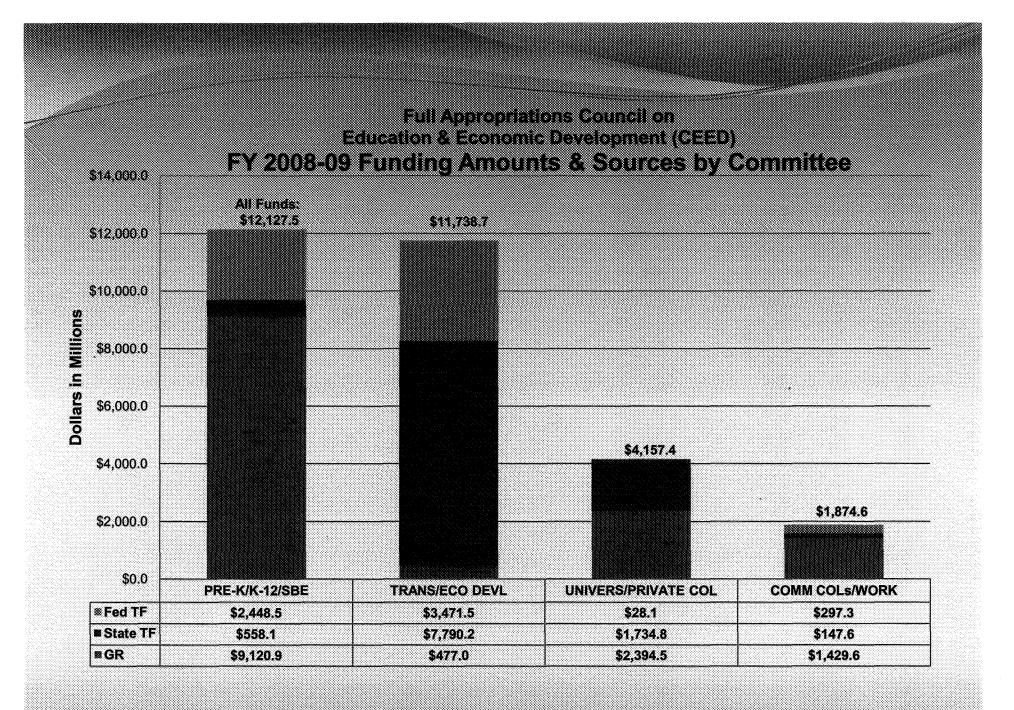


### FY 2008-09 Total State Budget by Council/Committee: \$66.3 Billion

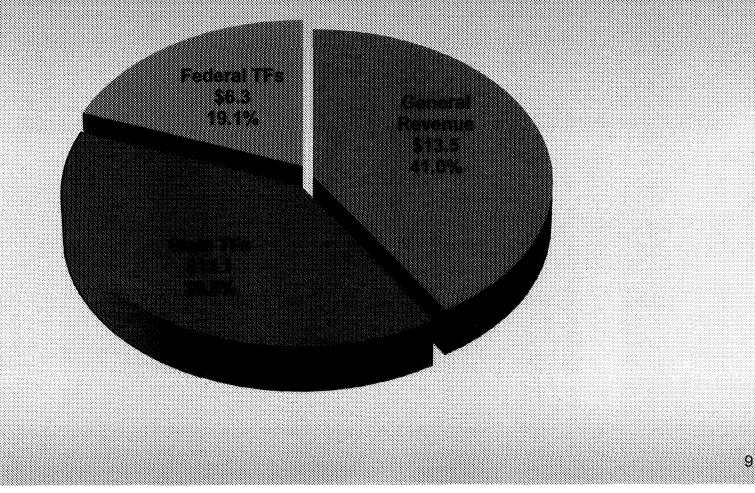

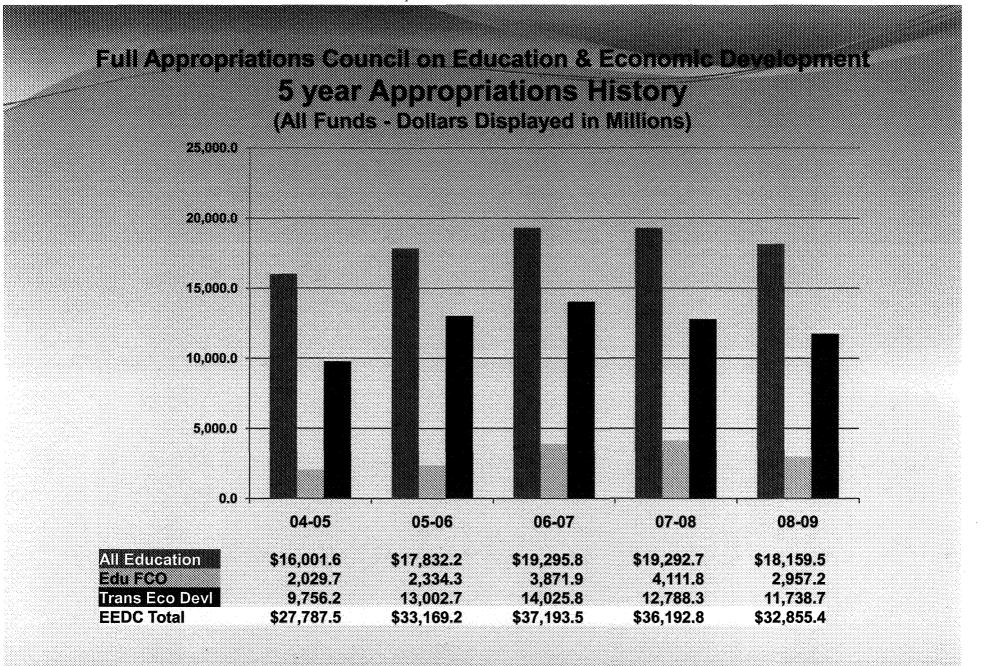




## Full Appropriations Council on Education & Economic Development (CEED) Funding Sources FY 2008-09
