- 381.921 Florida Cancer Council mission and duties.—The council, which shall work in concert with the Florida Center for Universal Research to Eradicate Disease to ensure that the goals of the center are advanced, shall endeavor to dramatically improve cancer research and treatment in this state through:

- <u>d.(d)</u> Encouraging the employment of bioinformatics in order to create a cancer informatics infrastructure that enhances information and resource exchange and integration through researchers working in diverse disciplines, to facilitate the full spectrum of cancer investigations;

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- $\underline{e.}$ (e) Facilitating the technical coordination, business development, and support of intellectual property as it relates to the advancement of cancer research; and
- $\underline{\text{f.(f)}}$ Aiding in other multidisciplinary research-support activities as they inure to the advancement of cancer research.
- 2.(2) Efforts to improve both research and treatment through greater participation in clinical trials networks by:
- $\underline{a.}$ (a) Identifying ways to increase adult enrollment in cancer clinical trials;
- $\underline{b.(b)}$ Supporting public and private professional education programs designed to increase the awareness and knowledge about cancer clinical trials;
- $\underline{\text{c.(c)}}$ Providing tools to cancer patients and community-based oncologists to aid in the identification of cancer clinical trials available in the state; and
- $\underline{d.(d)}$ Creating opportunities for the state's academic cancer centers to collaborate with community-based oncologists in cancer clinical trials networks.
- 3.(3) Efforts to reduce the impact of cancer on disparate groups by:
- $\underline{a.(a)}$ Identifying those cancers that disproportionately impact certain demographic groups; and
- $\underline{\text{b.}(b)}$ Building collaborations designed to reduce health disparities as they relate to cancer.
- (b) Preference may be given to grant proposals that foster collaborations among institutions, researchers, and community practitioners, as such proposals support the advancement of

Amendment No. 1 cures through basic or applied research, including clinical trials involving cancer patients and related networks.

(5) Funds appropriated for the William G. "Bill" Bankhead, Jr., and David Coley Cancer Research Program shall be distributed pursuant to this section to provide grants to researchers seeking cures for cancer and cancer-related illnesses, with emphasis given to the goals enumerated in this section s. 381.921. From the total funds appropriated, an amount of up to 10 percent may be used for administrative expenses. In the 2009-2010 fiscal year, 2.5 percent, not to exceed \$25 million, of the revenue deposited into the Health Care Trust Fund pursuant to s. 215.5602(12)(a) shall be transferred to the Biomedical Research Trust Fund within the Department of Health for the William G. "Bill" Bankhead, Jr., and David Coley Cancer Research Program.

Section 7. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
