Representative(s) Homan offered the following:

#### Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove everything after the resolving clause and insert:

That the Congress of the United States is urged to create a nationwide initiative to encourage physicians and medical specialists to increase their participation in providing on-call emergency room services by amending the nation's tax code to allow for all uncompensated emergency room work to be eligible as a charitable deduction against earned income for the practicing physician or medical specialist up to a maximum of \$100,000. Charges eligible for this deduction should be based on a rate equivalent to 200 percent of the Medicare reimbursement rate at the time the service is rendered. In the absence of an applicable Medicare billing code, the charge for this deduction should be based on a fee not to exceed 100 percent of the

average customary and reasonable charges allowed under private health insurance for any services rendered.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be dispatched to the President of the United States, to the President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and to each member of the Florida delegation to the United States Congress.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Medical Treatment and Labor Act provides that hospitals with an emergency department must provide emergency care without regard to the persons ability to pay for services, and

WHEREAS, many practitioners and specialists who are on-call provide services in emergency rooms to persons who are unable to pay for the services, and

WHEREAS, many physicians and medical specialists are not available to or are unwilling under current circumstances to provide on-call emergency room services, and
