Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert: Section 1. Heavy equipment rental; tangible personal property tax recovery fee. A person who engages in the business of renting heavy equipment under short term rental agreements may collect a tangible personal property tax recovery fee on the rental of heavy equipment. The purpose of the fee is to allow the owner of the heavy equipment to recover the tangible personal property taxes imposed upon the equipment. The amount of the fee must be disclosed in the rental agreement. The rate of the property tax recovery fee shall not exceed the rate of the tangible personal property tax imposed on such property by the county in which the equipment rental business is located. For purposes of this section, the term "heavy equipment" means industrial or construction equipment and includes, but is not limited to, equipment described in North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code 532412, as published in 2007

# HOUSE AMENDMENT FOR COUNCIL/COMMITTEE PURPOSES Amendment No.

by the Office of Management and Budget, Executive Office of the President. For purposes of this section, the term "short term rental agreement" includes only those lease or rental agreements for a term of less than 365 days or an at-will contract that does not specify the length of time of the contract. "Short term rental agreement" does not include any extension or renewal of a lease contract with an original term of one year or more.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.

#### TITLE AMENDMENT

Remove the entire title and insert:

An act relating to tangible personal property tax transparency; authorizing a person who rents heavy equipment to disclose the tangible personal property tax recovery fee in the rental agreement; defining the term "heavy equipment"; providing an effective date.
