Between lines 91 and 92, insert:

Section 2. Section 480.0535, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

480.0535 Documents required while working in a massage establishment.—

- (1) In order to provide the department and law enforcement agencies the means to more effectively identify, investigate, and arrest persons engaging in human trafficking:
- (a) A person employed by a massage establishment and any person performing massage therein must immediately present, upon the request of an investigator of the department or a law enforcement officer, valid government identification while in the establishment. A valid government identification for the purposes of this section is:
 - 1. A valid, unexpired driver's license issued by any state,

6. A valid, unexpired employment authorization card issued

(2) A person operating a massage establishment must:					
(a) Immediately present, upon the request of an					
investigator of the department or a law enforcement officer:					
1. Valid government identification while in the					
establishment.					
2. A copy of such documentation specified in paragraph					
(1)(a) for each employee and any person performing massage in					
the establishment.					
(b) Ensure that each employee and any person performing					
massage in the massage establishment is able to immediately					
present, upon the request of an investigator of the department					
or a law enforcement officer, valid government identification					
while in the establishment.					
(3) A person who violates any provision of this section					
commits:					
(a) A misdemeanor of the second degree for a first
